New game show provides parents-to-be with a chance to win money and prizes

You may have heard about a new series, known as *LABOR GAMES*, that will be airing on TLC. The first 12 episodes of the series were filmed at Pomona Valley Hospital Medical Center (PVHMC) with some of our patients while in labor in our Women's Center.

Facts about the Hospital's involvement:

- PVHMC is not affiliated with the program or its concept other than to serve as the game show site.
- PVHMC has not received any monetary compensation, nor do we provide any of the awarded gifts. And no Hospital Associates were compensated by TLC or the production company.
- Patient confidentiality was always respected and there were no violations of State or Federal patient privacy laws.
- Despite use of the word "surprise" in the show's description, contestants consented to participate in the game show prior to videotaping. And patients reported that they had a great experience playing the game.
- If at any time a patient or her unborn baby was in distress during labor, the medical staff had the authority to end videotaping.
- Patient privacy of all other patients in the hospital, and Hospital staff during taping was protected and there was no negative impact to the regular operations of the Labor & Delivery floor during taping.
- The program brings national positive exposure to our Women's Center and our outstanding staff and maternity services.
