

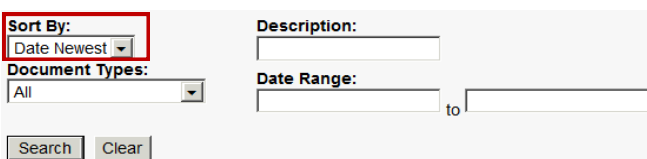
Medical History

Medical History

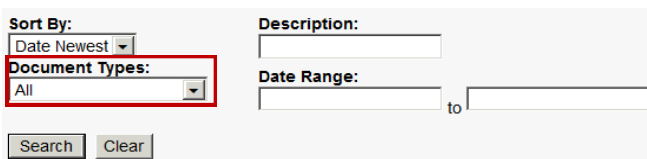
1. Select **Medical History** or **My Test Results & Clinical Summary Documents** to view available medical documents. Both selections reflect the same information. Screen will display the Medical History Inbox.



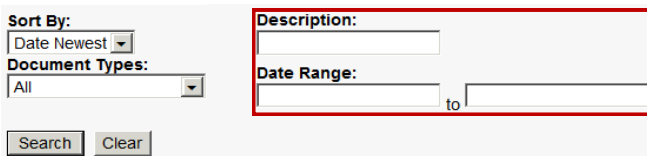
2. Select **Sort By (Date Newest or Oldest)** to filter the inbox results.



3. Select the **Document Type** to filter inbox results by the designated document.



4. Additional filters can be added by entering a document **Description** or by adding a **Date Range**.



5. Select **Search** to execute query.

1. Select the **View Document** icon of the document you would like to view. Screen displays the selected document.
