

REHABILITATION SERVICES



PEDIATRIC REHABILITATION

Pediatric Rehabilitation focuses on the developmental and special needs concerns of children from birth through adolescence. We offer comprehensive pediatric physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech and language therapy.

Our caring team of licensed PVHMC therapists includes American Speech-Language-Hearing Association pathologists, and a board certified Pediatric Clinical Specialist physical therapist. Our clinic is certified by the Joint Commission and California Children's Services (CCS) paneled.

We provide pediatric rehabilitation services at PVHMC's Milestones Center for Child Development, Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), and High Risk Infant Follow-Up Clinic.

Initiated in 1993, our program began with a single pediatric consultant assisting the NICU staff with feeding and developmental intervention. Now, more than two decades later, we have an entire staff of pediatric therapists and our own rehabilitation clinic, Milestones Center for Child Development.



PEDIATRIC REHABILITATION'S ROLE IN THE NEONATAL INTENSIVE CARE UNIT

As part of the interdisciplinary team of physicians, nurses and pediatric therapists in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, we work together to provide comprehensive care for babies that are born premature or ill. Our highly specialized therapists provide therapeutic touch and stretching activities, developmental care, and other diagnostic specific interventions. Feeding readiness and coordination are evaluated and ongoing education is given to parents and caregivers. The High Risk Infant Follow-Up Clinic monitors many NICU graduates for developmental delays until three years of age.



MILESTONES CENTER FOR CHILD DEVELOPMENT

Located in Claremont, Milestones is dedicated exclusively to the developmental needs of children. Our focus is to help our patients succeed in reaching the developmental milestones that will allow them to enjoy more independence as they continue to grow.

Our large pediatric clinic houses a spacious pediatric rehabilitation gym equipped to fit the needs of our young patients—including body-weight supported systems, a pediatric treadmill, private treatment rooms, and areas designed for sensory needs and speech and language therapy.

Milestones is open five days a week for appointments. We accept most insurance and can help with authorization. All of our services require a referral from a physician.



PEDIATRIC PHYSICAL THERAPY

Our pediatric physical therapists evaluate and treat children having difficulties with:

-  Gross motor development, postural alignment, flexibility, equilibrium, strength deficits, neuromotor development

Physical therapy addresses the acquisition of age appropriate developmental milestones including:

-  Sitting, crawling, standing, walking, running, jumping, kicking, throwing, stair climbing

Common diagnoses we serve include:

-  Torticollis, scoliosis, cerebral palsy, craniofacial asymmetries, lack of coordination, muscle imbalances, motor coordination, gait disturbance

Pediatric physical therapy empowers family and caregivers with home programs and hands-on demonstrations to support therapeutic goals that will enhance performance at home and in the community.

PEDIATRIC OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Our pediatric occupational therapists evaluate and treat children having difficulties with:

-  Fine motor development, coordination, auditory-visual-cognitive processing, sensory processing self-regulation, organization of behavior

Occupational therapy addresses the fundamental skills for performing activities of daily living including:

-  Feeding, self-care, play skills, attention to task, visual and motor tasks, social interaction, safety awareness

Common diagnoses we serve include:

-  Feeding disorders, autism, sensory processing disorders, attention disorders, brachial plexus injuries, fine motor delays, developmental delays, visual processing disorders, self-care (dressing, grooming, hygiene)

Pediatric occupational therapy works together with parents and caregivers to set age appropriate goals and programs for the home and in the community.

PEDIATRIC SPEECH AND LANGUAGE THERAPY

Our pediatric speech and language pathologists evaluate and treat a broad range of communicative disorders including:

-  Articulation/phonological disorders, stuttering/fluency disorders, receptive/expressive language disorders, pragmatic/social language disorders, selective mutism, audiological disorders

Speech and language therapy targets:

-  Joint-attention, turn-taking, compensatory articulator placement, hearing development, expressive/receptive language development, vocal play, caregiver education for modeling and reinforcing communicative acts at home and in the community

Common diagnoses we serve include:

-  Down syndrome, autism, cerebral palsy, speech delays, language delays, cleft palate, cleft lip, verbal apraxia, deaf and hard of hearing disorders

Pediatric speech and language therapy strives to help each child reach their highest potential through personalized treatment plans with an emphasis on communication readiness.
